1. Things to Bring

Your child will only need to bring the respective books according to the timetable given from Monday 4 Jan 2016 or when otherwise advised by his / her subject teacher. **Please note that it is fine if your child has yet to acquire the books / materials stipulated in the List. Just alert the Form Teacher will do. We will collect the books / materials when your child brings them to school.**

Your child should also bring these items to school **every day**:

- at least 2 sharpened 2B pencils
- an eraser
- a ruler
- a sharpener
- the Communication File (for homework, etc.) [Booklist Code L8]
- a small whiteboard, duster and a marker pen [Reuse from P2]
- simple pencil case or box (not too big or heavy)

**** Trolley bags are strongly discouraged.**



2. School Hours

The starting time for P3 students will be as per normal but we will end school earlier on Thursday (7 Jan 2016) for a week to allow our students to adjust to a new school year. The schedule will be as follows:

Note:

- We have set aside a break for 5 minutes starting at 12.00 pm to allow our students to go to the toilet or have an eye break, etc.
- Your child is allowed to bring a snack like biscuits or cut fruit to munch so that he / she will not feel very hungry before he / she reaches home for lunch. However, please avoid preparing a heavy meal for your child like rice, sandwiches or food that will take a while to consume. Such food should be consumed during recess.
- There will be no break on Thursdays as the students would have their lunch break at 12.00 pm for P3 students. They will share the same schedule and venue with the P4 students.
- The CCA will be offered to all P3 students. There will be a briefing session on CCA for our P3 students during the assembly period on Monday 18 Jan 2016. CCA will start from Friday 22 Jan 2016 from 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm. Tag Rugby will start later, from 3.00 pm to 5.00 pm. Outdoors and Adventure Club will only commence on Wednesday 27 Jan 2016.
- Please refer to the Letter to Parents dated 17 Nov 2015 with regard to SwimSafer Programme for P3 students. It will start on Week 1 over 8 weeks (1.5 hour per week). Every Tuesday (starting from 5 Jan 2016) for 3 Diamond, Emerald and Jade. Every Wednesday (starting from 6 Jan 2016) for 3 Amethyst, Opal and Pearl.

3. Timetable and Student Handbook 2016

Your child will receive his / her timetable on the first day.

It will be pasted in the Student Handbook 2016. He / She should pack his / her bag every day and bring only the books required for that day.



Please read and go through the content found in the Student Handbook 2016.

4. Dismissal

The dismissal time for the first week from Monday 4 Jan to Friday 8 Jan 2016 will be at 1.40 pm. However, there may be a slight delay to the dismissal time on the initial few days as we need to orientate our students to the new routine. We will dismiss our students at the following pick up points as per last year:

1) Back Gate

The gate is situated at the back of the school, leading to the public basketball court and children's playground. Preferred dismissal point for all students. Owing to the larger

waiting area for parents and care givers with covered walkway leading to Treelodge and Coralinus, it will be safer for the students to be dismissed from the back gate.

2) Punggol Place Gate

The gate near to the Bus Stop. For students going home by bus or MRT / LRT.

3) Foyer

To be picked up by car. Parents are allowed to drive in to pick your child after dismissal. The gate will open immediately after the school buses leave the school premises.

- Estimated time at 1.55 pm from 4 Jan to 8 Jan 2016
- Estimated time at 1.50 pm from 11 Jan 2016 onwards (For Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday)
- Estimated time at 3.50 pm from 14 Jan 2016 onwards (Thursday)

5) Student Care Centre

We would be very grateful if you could alert your child as well as the Form Teacher which pick up point you would be picking your child up from.

Should you be late in coming to fetch your child, you may call the General Office at 6570 1588. We will be most happy to look after your child at the Foyer area, near the General Office. Please proceed straight to the General Office to fetch your child home.
