We would like to invite you and your family to participate in the Community Sports Day on Saturday 23 Jul 2016 in Punggol View Primary School.

This community-based project is a collaboration between Punggol Coast CC and the school to promote active and healthy lifestyles and family bonding for the residents in Punggol Coast Constituency through sports and games.

Participants are required to buy a ticket to enter and participate in the activities. Priced at S\$2.00 per adult/child. It will entitle the ticket holder entry to the school and participate in the sports and games clinics. The cost is used to defray the provision of a McDonald's muffin, ice cream, a bottle water, an apple and a pack of biscuits. This food pack will be presented to each ticket holder.

Upon completing three out of the six sports and games clinics (in bold), the ticket holder can claim a free goodie bag. This means that the ticket holder can choose to complete three clinics out of the following six, namely Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket, Golf or Tchouk Ball.

We will be setting up a booth outside the General Office to sell the tickets to our students during recess on

- Monday 11 Jul from 9.00 am to 10.25 am,
- Thursday 14 Jul from 9.00 am to 10.25 am, and
- Thursday 21 Jul from 9.00 am to 10.25 am.

The sale of tickets will be at S\$2.00 per adult/child. For example, a family with two adults and three children will require 5 tickets at a total cost S\$10.00.

We would like to alert you that selected students will be invited to participate in the Racial Harmony Challenge, while a handful from various CCAs will be tasked to assist as student volunteers to help manage the various sports and games clinics listed above. These students will be given a free ticket each so that they can participate in the activities as well as collect the food pack. Consent forms will be issued to the students directly by the teachers overseeing the activities.

We would be grateful if you and your family could make time to join us in participating in the event on Saturday 23 Jul 2016 from 8.30 am to 12.00 pm. It will be a fun time for family bonding as well as to participate in sports and games clinics.
