#### ROAD SAFETY OF OUR STUDENTS

Our students, staff and parents are very precious to us in our Punggol View family. We would like to keep our school and family safe for everyone. We would like to seek your support and cooperation to ensure the safety of our students and other people coming in and leaving the school. This is especially important as our young children may not have the skills required to use the roads properly and they may not fully appreciate the dangers presented. Their small physique also makes them less visible to the motorists.

We want to reiterate the school's Road Safety Policies with you:

- a. We would be very grateful if you could drive slowly and carefully in the school zone. Please do reduce your vehicle speed and stay alert for pedestrians crossing. Please be advised not to violate the traffic rules by driving recklessly or making manoeuvres that may not be appropriate such as turning into the school from the outer lane(s) of the road.
- b. Should you plan to drive your child to school, the school's Foyer is the designated drop-off/pick-up point during morning arrival and school dismissal. Please do cooperate with our staff and traffic marshals to ensure the overall safety and smooth traffic flow. Let your child alight or board your vehicle only at the designated drop-off/pick-up point. Please do not cut the path of the vehicle(s) in front of you. This could be very dangerous for both parties, and an accident or even a dispute may arise from this act.
- c. To ensure the smooth traffic flow along the main road, parents are discouraged from parking along and/or waiting along the main road especially during dismissal time. This is because we might end up disrupting the SBS bus from alighting the passengers and /or picking up the passengers at the bus bay next to the school. The school gate will only be open after our school buses have left the school's premises, and we would like to advise that you come in after 1.50 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, and 3.50 pm on Thursday, to pick up your child/children.
- d. Be considerate to other parents waiting in-line to drop-off/pick-up their children. Help your child alight from the car as quickly as possible. Avoid leaving your car and help your child down as this may takes longer than usual and affect the other parents waiting in-line. Please do not horn indiscriminately too. Let us be a little patient as road courtesy is a virtue we want our children to learn from us.
- e. If you are driving in to pick up your child from student care in the evening, please park your car at the parking lots. Please avoid parking your car at the foyer area as it is also used as a designated pick-up point and we need to maintain a smooth flow of traffic around the school.

For safety of everyone concerned, enforcement actions will be taken against motorists who violate traffic rules. You may wish to read the road safety advice to your child/children in the Student handbook (pages 21 to 24). We would like to thank you for being the role models for our children. Thank you.
