Reminders for Sep Holidays

We are coming to the end of Term 3 and Wednesday 30 Aug 2017 will be the last day of Term 3. We will break from Thursday 31 Aug to Sunday 10 Sep 2017. The General Office and Student Care will remain open on Thursday 31 Aug 2017 and during the one week school holiday. Your child will return to school for the new Term on Monday 11 Sep 2017. Your child will receive a new time-table for Term 4. However, we will follow the Term 3 time-table for Monday 11 Sep 2017.

ABCD Holiday Reminder

Your child is precious to us in our Punggol View family and it is a timely to communicate our ABCD holiday reminder. Leading to this term break, we will be communicating to our students the need to take good care of themselves at home and outside home. Please do help us to reiterate the following messages:

- A: Avoid talking to strangers
- B: Be Safe at home and outside home
- C: Cross the road carefully
- D: Do the right Thing

Avoid talking to strangers. Please remind your child to be mindful when interacting with strangers. They must not open the house door to allow strangers to enter or to follow strangers. They can be polite in showing direction to strangers, but they must also politely decline conveying too much information about themselves and the family to strangers.

Be safe at home and outside school. Please do remind your child not to play with water, electrical switches/appliances and matches. Should they be hurt, they must inform an adult to nurse the wound. They should also be careful when they play at the playground and avoid playing with people who may hurt or harm them.

Cross the road safely. We want our students to practise road safety. Some of our students may be cycling along the road, and we want them to develop good habits while using the road and to pay attention to road conditions. Please refer to Student's Handbook for details on Road Safety Advice for Our Students (p.23-24) and Road Safety Advice to Cyclists (p.25-26).

Do the right thing. We reminded our students to practise our school's values in particular to be respectful and responsible. They must keep their belongings properly and help with household chores at home. We would like to encourage our parents to use our values to get them to do the right thing too.

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Travel Plan


