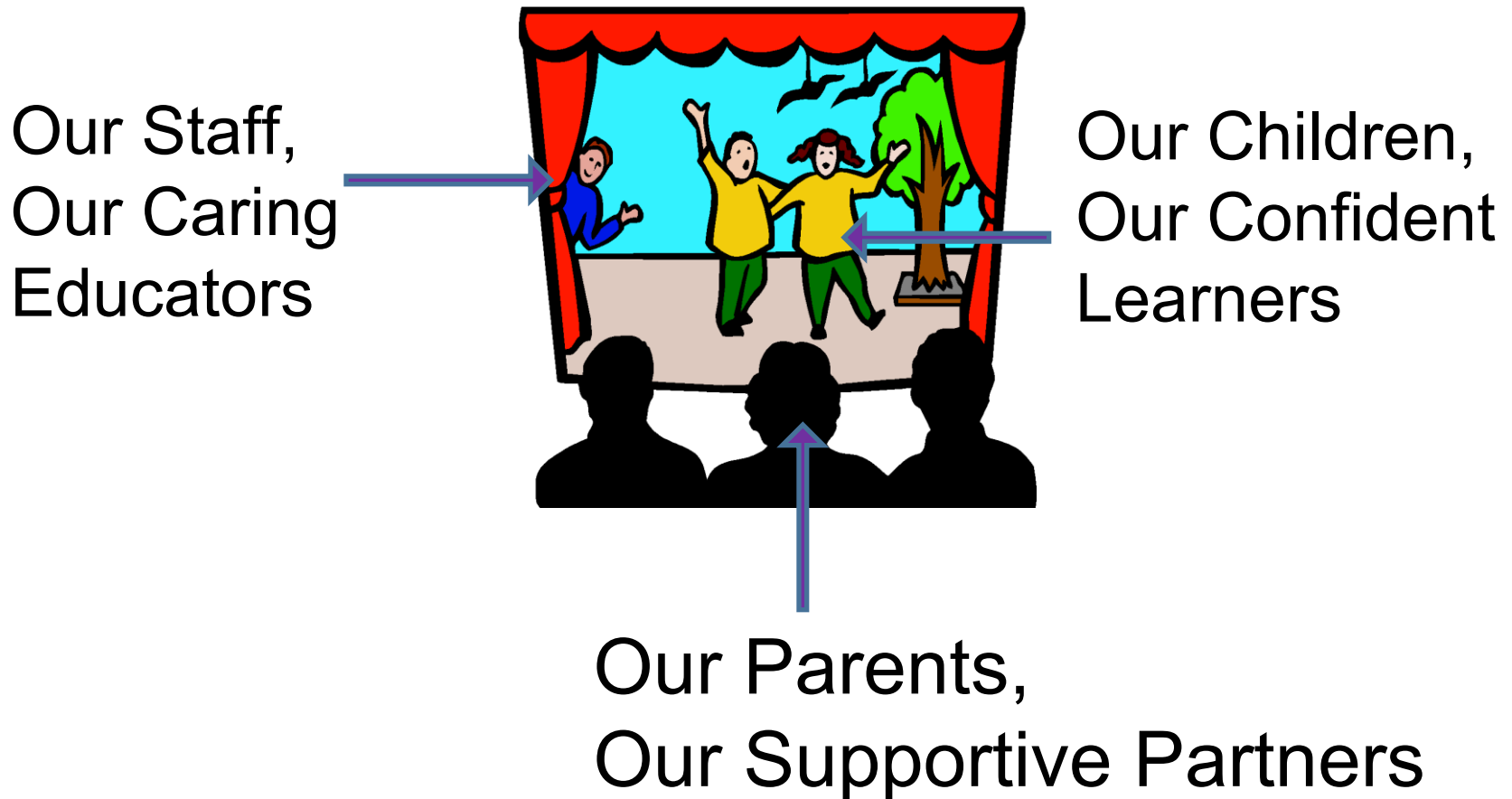

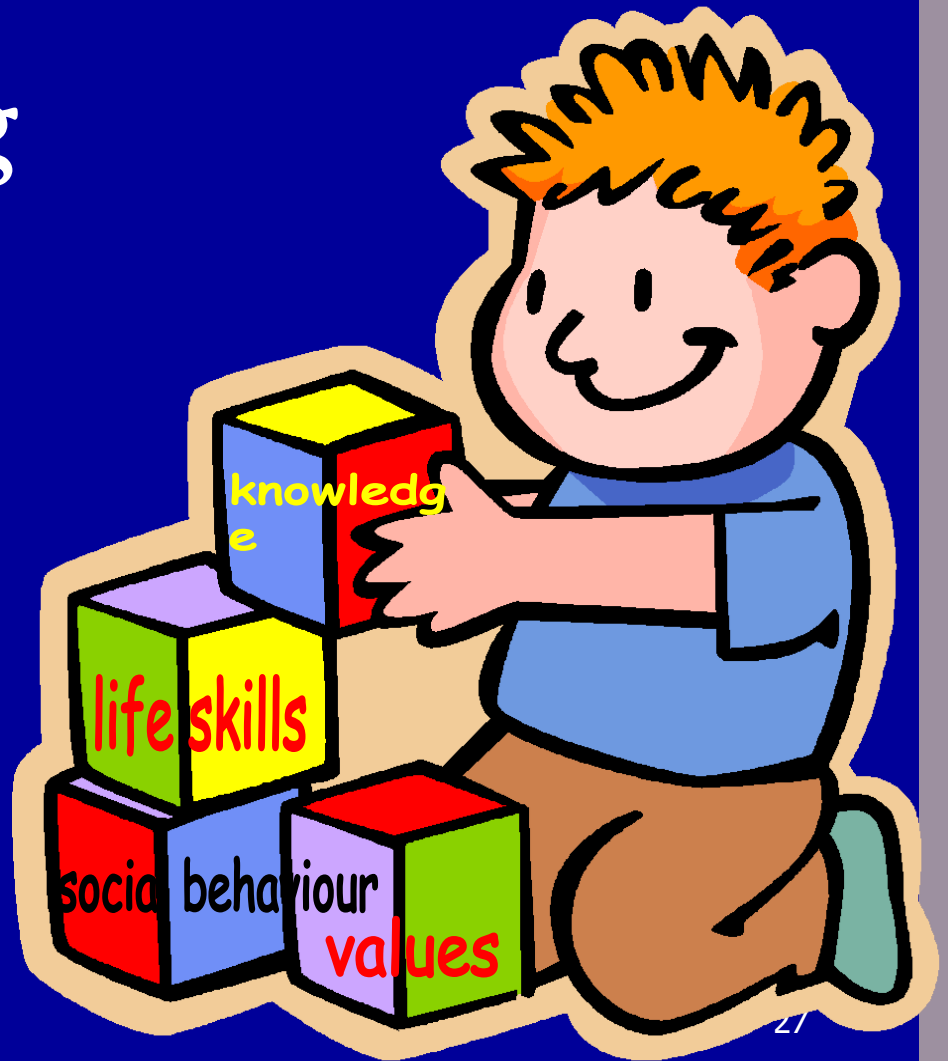

HOW is learning organised in Punggol View Primary School ...

The school adopts SEED programme
(Strategies for Effective Engagement & Development)

- Class size of 30-32
- Literacy programme with focus on reading
- More activity-based lessons e.g. learning centres, learning journeys
- More teacher-prepared materials; textbooks as resources
- Informal, continual and alternative assessments; beyond pen-and-paper (Holistic Assessment since 2013)

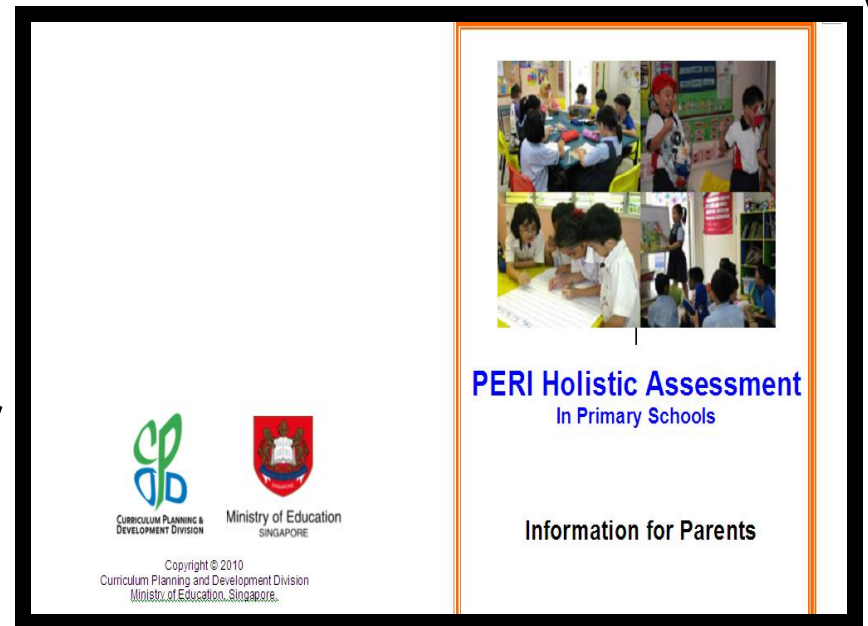

PGVP School Hours for 2026...

Curriculum starts : 7.45 a.m.

- ❖ Different timing for 1st 3 days (2 Jan and 5 Jan to 6 Jan) especially for P1
- ❖ Day 1, 2 and 3 – report at 8 a.m.; Purpose to synchronise with other levels....
- ❖ All students must be in Punggol View Primary Uniform
- ❖ Your child has the option of wearing /not wearing mask as guided by national posture; If your child is not well, he/she is advised to wear mask.

Day 4 (7 Jan) onward- Reporting time is at 7.30 am . Same as other levels.

In a nutshell: First Day of School...

- ❖ Only P1 and K1 students and parents will be in school on **Friday 2 Jan 2026**... (Day 1 of school for P1 students)
- ❖ Report at 8.00 a.m. Students will proceed to the canteen where a teacher will bring your child up to the classroom
- ❖ Parents to register at the Hall for the Interaction with Principal session
- ❖ Recess Time - Get the chance to see your child having recess

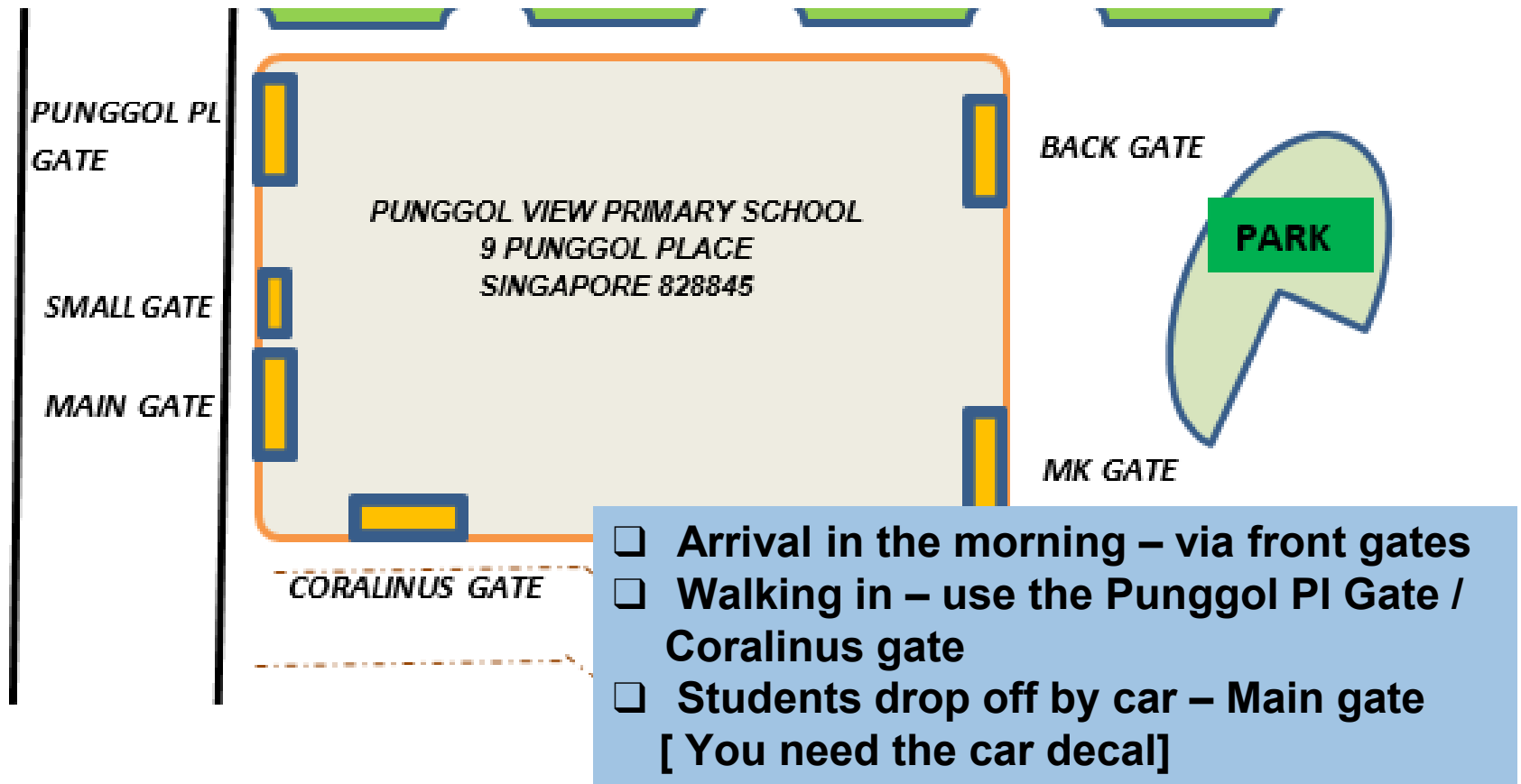

First 3 days (2, 5 and 6 Jan)– P1 will report at 8.00 am

Dismissal @ IBC....



- The official dismissal time is at 1.30 p.m.
- Dismissal for 1st day(2 Jan) is at 11.30 a.m.
- Dismissal for 5 Jan & 6 Jan is at 1 p.m.
- Students will be dismissed at the Backgate. Parents will wait at the respective assigned backgate.
- Others will be assembled at the IBC. They will be grouped into the following dismissal points
