





# PGVP School Hours for 2025...

Curriculum starts : 7.30 a.m.

- ❖ Different timing for 1<sup>st</sup> 3 days ( 2 Jan to 3 Jan and 6 Jan) especially for P1 .....
- ❖ Day 1, 2 and 3 – report at 8 a.m.; Purpose to synchronise with other levels....
- ❖ All students must be in school uniform
- ❖ Your child has the option of wearing /not wearing mask as guided by national posture; If not well, good to wear mask.

**Day 4 ( 7 Jan)** onward- Reporting time is at 7.25 am . Same as other levels.



# In a nutshell: First Day of School...

- ❖ Only P1 and K1 students and parents will be in school on **Thursday 2 Jan 2024...** ( Day 1 of school for P1 students)
- ❖ Report at 8.00 a.m. Students will proceed to the canteen where a teacher will bring your child up to the classroom
- ❖ Parents to register at the Hall for the Interaction with Principal session
- ❖ Recess Time - Get the chance to see your child having recess
- ❖ **Parent Engagement session in the Hall after recess...**

- Would like all parents to be on board.







# Dismissal @ IBC....



- The official dismissal time is at 1.30 p.m.
- Dismissal for 1st day(2 Jan) is at 12.00 p.m.
- Dismissal for 3 Jan & 6 Jan is at 1 p.m.
- Students will be dismissed at the Backgate. Parents will wait at the respective assigned backgate.
