PGVP School Hours for 2025...

Curriculum starts: 7.30 a.m.

- Different timing for 1st 3 days (2 Jan to 3 Jan and 6 Jan) especially for P1
- Day 1, 2 and 3 report at 8 a.m.; Purpose to synchronise with other levels....
- All students must be in school uniform
- Your child has the option of wearing /not wearing mask as guided by national posture; If not well, good to wear mask.

Day 4 (7 Jan) onward- Reporting time is at 7.25 am. Same as other levels.



In a nutshell: First Day of School...



Dismissal @ IBC....





- The official dismissal time is at 1.30 p.m.
- Dismissal for 1st day(2 Jan) is at 12.00 p.m.
- Dismissal for 3 Jan & 6 Jan is at 1 p.m.
- Students will be dismissed at the Backgate. Parents will wait at the respective assigned backgate.
- Others will be assembled at the IBC. They will be grouped into the following dismissal points
